

Works Update

Blacktown and Mount Druitt Hospitals - Additional Beds

March 2026

Blacktown Hospital

The NSW Government has committed \$120 million to upgrade Blacktown and Mount Druitt Hospitals to increase bed capacity and respond to community health needs.

Health Infrastructure has engaged Icon to deliver 30 beds at Blacktown Hospital. The project also includes clinical and non-clinical spaces across the hospital.

These works are contained within Blacktown Hospital and include:

- Installation of new building services including electrical, mechanical, fire and plumbing.
- Installation of new walls and ceilings.
- Installation of new vinyl flooring and paint/vinyl wall finishes, doors, joinery, fixtures and equipment.

Timing of the work

Work will take place between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday, Saturday between 8am and 1pm. No work is planned on Sundays or Public Holidays. Regular after-hours work is not expected however exceptions may occur for delivery of materials, service connections, shutdowns, or works that cannot be performed during standard hours.

Delivery of the new beds is programmed to be completed by late 2026. Completion dates for additional clinical and non-clinical works will be confirmed following further construction programming and delivery timeframes.

How will the work affect you?

Construction vehicles will use the Marcel Crescent access point and the internal hospital road to access the construction control point. Blacktown Road Entry will be used as a secondary construction entrance in exceptional circumstances only.

The work is not expected to have any impact on hospital parking.

All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority, and to minimise impacts upon operation of the hospital.

We endeavour to keep noise, dust and vibration to a minimum and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by planning work effectively to reduce impacts from construction activities.
